I also, give permission to Oregon Trail Recreation District, sponsors, and partners to use my likeness, photo, video, name, voice, and words in the newspaper, website or appear in any public forums.

I also understand that at any OTRD event, practice, or competition, any adult who verbally abuses, attempts to intimidate, is flagrantly rude to, or does not control their language or actions with a player, official, coach, spectator, person, or OTRD employee/volunteer will be asked to leave the event. If the violator fails to leave upon request, law enforcement authorities may be called to remove the person. Any adult who physically assaults an player, official, coach, person, or OTRD employee/volunteer will be banned from OTRD for a minimum one year from the date of the offense. After one year, the person may apply for reinstatement. If the adult commits a second offense, he or she will be permanently banned from OTRD.

The term physical assault includes, but is not limited to: hitting, slapping, pushing, spitting, kicking or striking in anyway with any part of the body or any physical implement. Any coach of an OTRD program who gets removed from a game will be suspended from coaching the following game. If a coach gets removed from a game the second time, he/she will not be able to coach for the remainder of the season and will have to meet with OTRD supervisor and board of directors to petition to coach again for the Oregon Trail Rec District.
