

## PRIORITY OF USE AND FEE CHART

GROUP	DEFINITION	FEES
GROUP I	Programs administered by the Oregon Trail Recreation District (OTRD)	No Charge
GROUP II	Programs or activities sponsored by the School District with which the OTRD has a reciprocal facility use agreements and in-kind services	May request and be granted a waiver of charges at the discretion of the OTRD Board of Directors
GROUP III	<p>Recreation events, programs, and non-profit organizations, whose scope and purpose are recognized primarily as a recreation service to the citizens residing in the OTRD. (Typical groups in this category would be the local non-profits such as youth sports organizations and park and recreation partners). These organizations must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Be based in the boundaries of the OTRD</li> <li>b) Be non-profit making and show evidence thereof; or evidence that an application has been made for non-profit status</li> <li>c) Have an official organization structure and status and show evidence thereof</li> <li>d) Require that events and programs held on or at OTRD facilities must be open to the general public</li> </ul>	
GROUP IV	Non-profit organizations, activities, and events not meeting the criteria in classifications I through III	
GROUP V	<p>Private and commercial use and any other activities, and events not meeting the criteria in classification I through IV</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Activities such as weddings, receptions, dinners, private parties, industrial conferences, and training seminars</li> <li>b) Rental fees will be charged for all events.</li> </ul>	
GROUP VI	Commercial business or professionals engaged in activities for private gain or profit	Pay use fees for all events according to the current fee schedule, including supervision and cleaning
Ineligible Organizations, Programs, Clubs, and Events	Groups, for any reason, deemed not in the best interest of the community by the OTRD Board of Directors	NA
